Dr Ralf Herold PhD works in the EMA's Regulatory Science and Innovation Task Force where he co-leads the workstream on research and innovation. The task force works for the continuous futureproofing of the Agency and of the European medicines regulatory network by addressing key scientific and technological trends and their translation through the regulatory science strategy, planning and governance.

Ralf coordinates the Agency's involvement in external regulatory science activities and academia liaison, horizon scanning, and the regulatory science research needs initiative. He is a member of the EU Agencies' Network on Scientific Advice (EU ANSA) and a co-chair of the EU Innovation Network's Horizon Scanning group.

He worked at the Agency since 2007 in several scientifically responsible functions, including for medicine development for paediatric populations and for patients with a cancer, engaging intensively with patient organisations and learned societies, contributing to EU policy initiatives. From 2017 to 2018, he was the Pediatric development leader of Bayer AG, Regulatory affairs, and was the Biotechnology Innovation Organization's delegate to the International Council for Harmonisation E11A. At Humboldt university in Berlin, Germany, he worked as physician for patients in a tertiary-care hospital since 1994, obtained an experimental research PhD, board-certified in paediatric and adolescent medicine, and managed a national clinical research network in paediatric oncology and haematology until 2007.
